UPDATED PLA PUBLICATION

GENERAL DIRECTIONS 2021

GD 14 – RESTRICTED VISIBILITY

In July 2020, the Port of London Authority (PLA) consulted publicly on proposed changes to the General Directions for Navigation in the Port of London 2016, including a change to the General Direction regarding Restricted Visibility. In response to feedback received during the consultation, the PLA agreed to withhold proposed changes to this GD pending further review and consultation.

Following the completion of that process, a revised General Direction on Restricted Visibility will be published as an amendment to the latest version of the General Directions and will become effective as of 7th July 2021.

Please ensure that any printed copies of the publication are amended accordingly, and any downloads are replaced with the latest version.
