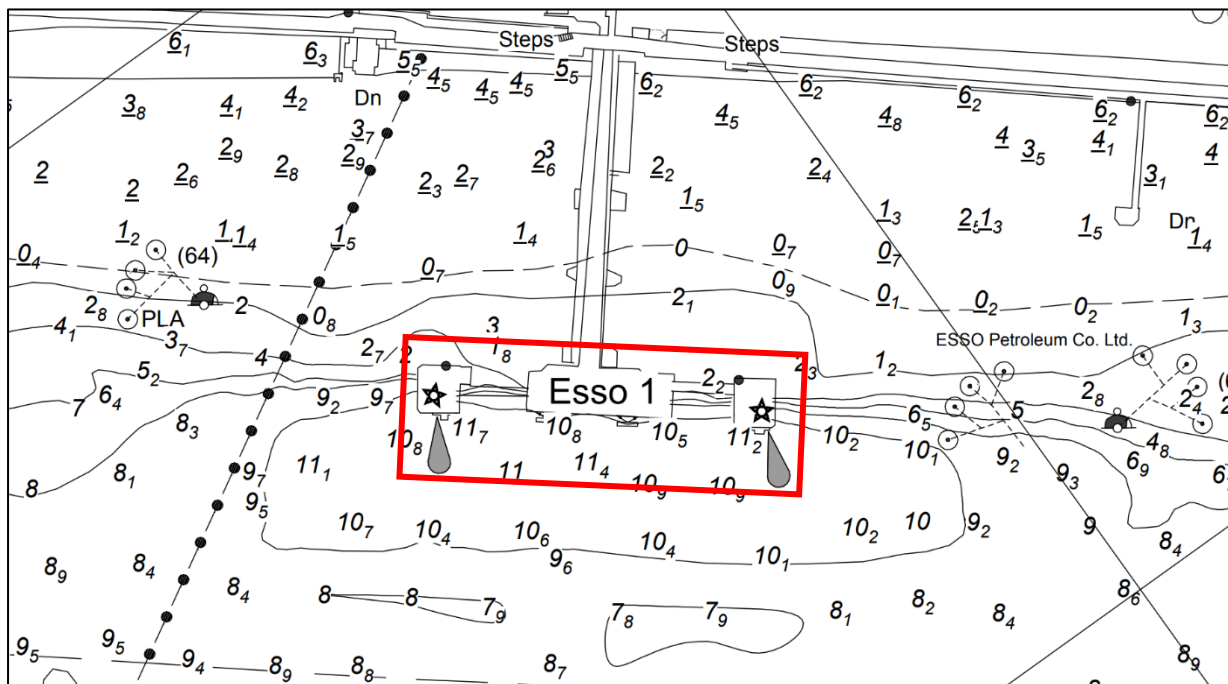


NOTICE TO MARINERS L17 of 2020

LONG REACH ESSO No.1 JETTY FENDER REFURBISHMENT WORKS

On or about 9th November 2020 works will commence to refurbish the fender panels at Esso No.1 Jetty, which are anticipated to take approximately six weeks. The chartlet below depicts the location and marine footprint of the works:



The works, which will involve heavy lifting operations, will be undertaken from the crane barge RAVESTEIN between the hours of 0600 and 1800.

Safety boat DIVECO V will also be in attendance during the works.

London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to “proceed with caution” or “proceed at slow speed”, as described in Permanent Notices to Mariners 4 of 2014 as required by the works. International Code Flags “Romeo Yankee” will be displayed when this is in effect.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 68 as required.
