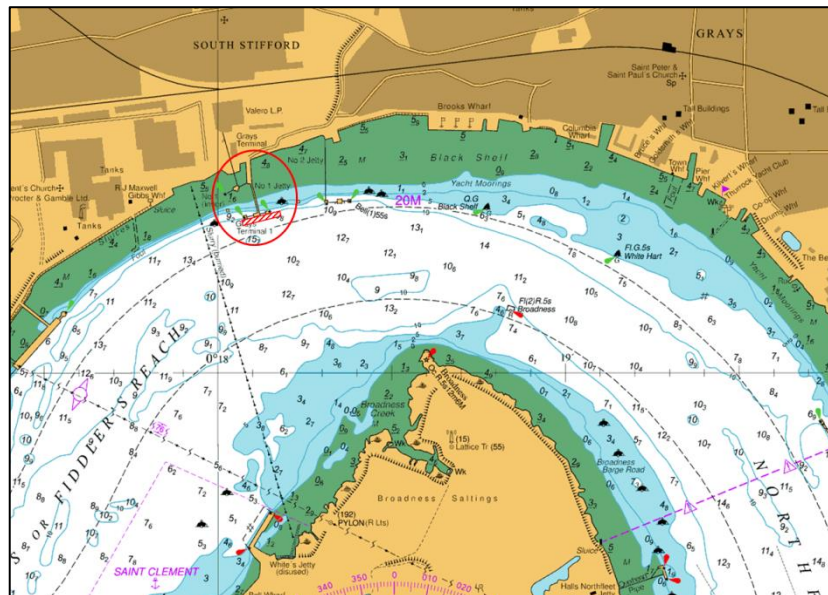


## NOTICE TO MARINERS      L21 of 2017

### ST CLEMENTS REACH GRAYS TERMINAL JETTY WORKS & DREDGING OPERATIONS

Mariners are advised that commencing on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> September work will commence on GRAYS TERMINAL JETTY NO.1 for the removal of piles and fendering. The work will be carried out from the HAVEN SEAFORTH spudleg Barge. In addition to this two hopper barges will be used to transport material away from site. The tug HORTON or MOLLY G will be in attendance and maintaining a listening watch on VHF Channel 68.



These works will be carried out between 0700 and 1900 during which time mariners are requested to be mindful of the speed and wash when passing this area.

In addition to the above jetty works dredging operations will commence on 16<sup>th</sup> October 2017 for approximately 4 weeks with all works expected to be completed by the end of November 2017. Dredging will be carried out within the jetty's dredged box area adjacent to the main navigation channel and will display lights and shapes according to the collision regulations. Due to this operation a "Proceed with Caution", as per Permanent Notice to Mariners, will be in force for all vessels rounding Broadness. A listening watch will be maintained on VHF Channel 68 at all times.
