

NOTICE TO MARINERS L2 of 2019

WEST LEIGH BUOY

TEMPORARY EMERGENCY WRECK MARKING BUOY

A vessel has sunk in position 51° 30.586458N 000°38.728122E in the vicinity of the W Leigh Middle Buoy.

While measures are put in place to recover the vessel a temporary Emergency Wreck Marking Buoy has been placed to warn mariners.

The buoy is fitted an alternating blue and yellow flashing light with a nominal range of 4 nautical miles where the blue and yellow 1 second flashes are alternated with an interval of 0.5 seconds.

Attempts to recover the vessel will be carried out as soon as possible.
