

NOTICE TO MARINERS L30 of 2015

GRAVESEND REACH TILBURY RO-RO PONTOON REMOVAL

Mariners are advised that commencing on or around 11th January 2016 contractors working on behalf of the Port of Tilbury will be undertaking works to remove a beached pontoon adjacent to Tilbury Ro-Ro berth.

The works consisting of the cutting and disposal of the pontoon will be undertaken by the crane barge SEA REACH with the assistance of a work boat. The SEA REACH will be secured alongside the Ro-Ro berth utilising both mooring lines and spud legs.

The works will predominantly be undertaken between mid and low states of tide and only when possible allowing for the normal shipping schedule to be maintained.

All vessels are required to reduce speed and proceed with caution whilst passing when work is underway, and at all times when advised by London VTS.

Further details of when work is being undertaken, as well as any temporary restrictions to passing traffic, will be broadcast by London VTS.
