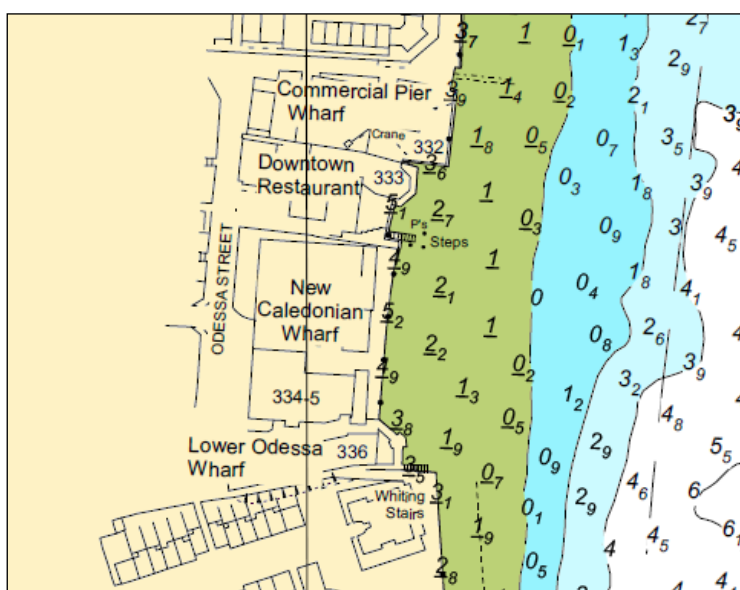


## NOTICE TO MARINERS M11 of 2018

### LIMEHOUSE REACH FORMER DOWNTOWN RESTAURANT DECONSTRUCTION WORKS

Contractors working on behalf of Hollybrook Homes will be deconstructing the piles supporting the former Downtown Restaurant on Odessa Street.



On or about **Monday 26<sup>th</sup> February 2018** the Crane Barge HAVEN SEAFORTH will be mobilised to the site to begin the deconstruction works with the tug HORTON. The works are expected to take approximately two weeks and will be supported by the safety boat MOLLY G which will be on station throughout the operations and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 14.

The HAVEN SEAFORTH will display the lights and shapes as prescribed in Rule 27 of the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea 1972 namely:

- By day, three black shapes in a vertical line the highest and lowest of which are balls and the middle one a diamond
- By night, three all round lights in a vertical line the highest and lowest of which are red and the middle one white

London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to “proceed with caution” or “proceed at slow speed”, as described in Permanent Notices to Mariners 4 of 2014 as required by the works. International Code flags “Romeo Yankee” will be displayed when this is in effect.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
