

# NOTICE TO MARINERS M23 of 2022

## CHELSEA REACH

### LOCAL TRAFFIC CONTROL FILMING OPERATIONS

Filming operations are being conducted with support from marine contractors Livett Launches in Chelsea Reach on the dates listed below. These operations will involve; a number of vessels, low flying Helicopters and Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV).

Filming will take place on the following dates and times:

Date	Start Time	Finish Time
Saturday 21st May 2022	07:00	15:00
Sunday 22nd May 2022	09:00	15:00
Tuesday 31st May 2022	12:00	15:00
Saturday 25th June	07:30	15:00

To support these operations a Port of London Authority (PLA) Harbour Service Launch will be in the vicinity to provide Local Traffic Control, if and when required.

When Local Traffic Control is established, the launches will display flashing blue lights. All vessels intending to navigate between Victoria Railway Bridge and Lot's Road Creek are to call 'ALBERT CONTROL' on VHF Channel 14 as follows:

- Inbound at Victoria Railway Bridge
- Outbound at Lot's Road Creek
- Prior to leaving a berth or mooring between Victoria Railway Bridge and Lot's Road Creek.

All vessels on the river are to navigate with caution and are to maintain a continuous watch on VHF Channel 14, following instructions from the attending Harbour Service Launches.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
