

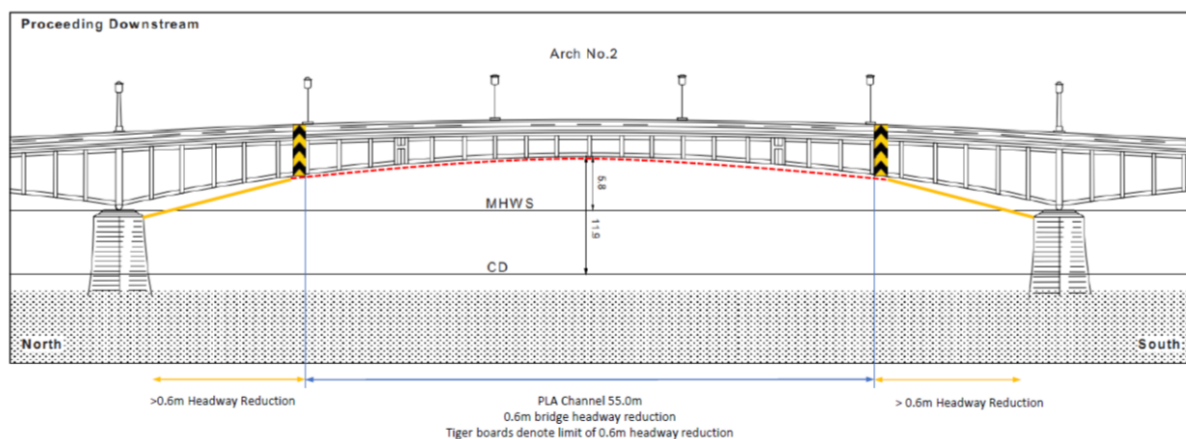
NOTICE TO MARINERS M26 of 2021

WANDSWORTH REACH WANDSWORTH BRIDGE SCAFFOLDING

This notice supplements NTM M54 of 2020 and supersedes NTM M22 of 2021 which is cancelled.

Contractors working on Wandsworth Bridge refurbishment have completed scaffolding the bridge. Encapsulation of the scaffolding will be completed by mid-June. No 2 arch of Wandsworth Bridge will remain open but with restricted channel width and reduced height.

Please see the figure below depicting the encapsulated scaffolding. The section between the striped tiger boards will have the headway reduced by 600mm. At all times Vessels should only navigate between the two Tiger boards.



The isophase lights are covered by the encapsulation and will be replaced during the refurbishment.

Reporting vessels should use all available means to identify other reporting vessels navigating in the area and make passing arrangements as necessary.

Dismantling of the scaffolding in number 2 arch should begin in October 2021 and all scaffolding removed from the bridge by January 2022.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
