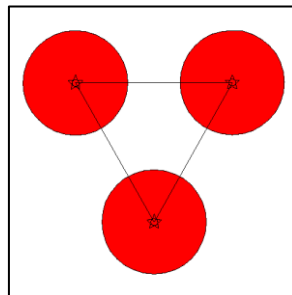
BATTERSEA REACH BATTERSEA RAIL BRIDGE ARCH CLOSURES

This notice replaces M28 of 2022 which is hereby cancelled

Contractors working on behalf of Network Rail will be conducting abseiling operations on Battersea Rail Bridge from **Monday 4th July 2022** to **Friday 8th July 2022**. In order to accommodate these works, arches on Battersea Rail Bridge will be closed to navigation as follows:

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws 2012:



Abseiling will also be taking place on Arch No. 2 on Tuesday 5th July 2022 and Arch No. 3 on Wednesday 6th July 2022; however, the abseiler's will not be break the silhouette of the bridge and will remain open to navigation.

Safety boat WATCHDOG will be on station maintaining a listening watch on VHF Channel 14.

Further details will be broadcast by **London VTS** on VHF Channel 14.
