

NOTICE TO MARINERS M2 of 2019

KINGS REACH CANNON STREET RAIL BRIDGE ARCH CLOSURES

Contractors working on behalf of the Illuminated River Foundation will be conducting survey works on Cannon Street Railway Bridge from **Thursday 10th January 2019** until **Sunday 13th of January 2019**. In order to accommodate these works, arches on Cannon Street Bridge will be closed to navigation as follows:-

Safety boat "PROTECTOR" will be on station throughout operations and will maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 14.

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws 2012 namely:

- By day, three red discs 0.6 metres in diameter at the points of an equilateral triangle with the apex downwards and the base horizontal
- By night, three red lights in similar positions to the discs displayed by day.

Further details will be broadcast by **London VTS** on **VHF Channel 14**.
