

NOTICE TO MARINERS M30 of 2019

NINE ELMS REACH BATTERSEA POWER STATION JETTY BRIDGE INSTALLATION

On or about **Wednesday 15th May 2019** contractors will be installing two bridges between the shore and Battersea Power Station Jetty. The crane barge **DEVELOPER** will be moored on spud legs positioned outside the current jetty. It is expected the works will take approximately ten weeks.

London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to “proceed with caution” or “proceed at slow speed”, as described in Permanent Notices to Mariners 4 of 2014 as required by the works. International Code flags “Romeo Yankee” will be displayed when this is in effect. All vessels are to navigate in this area with caution, maintaining a continuous watch on VHF Channel 14 and follow the instructions from London VTS.

Safety boat **DEVICE** will be on station throughout operations and will maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 14.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
