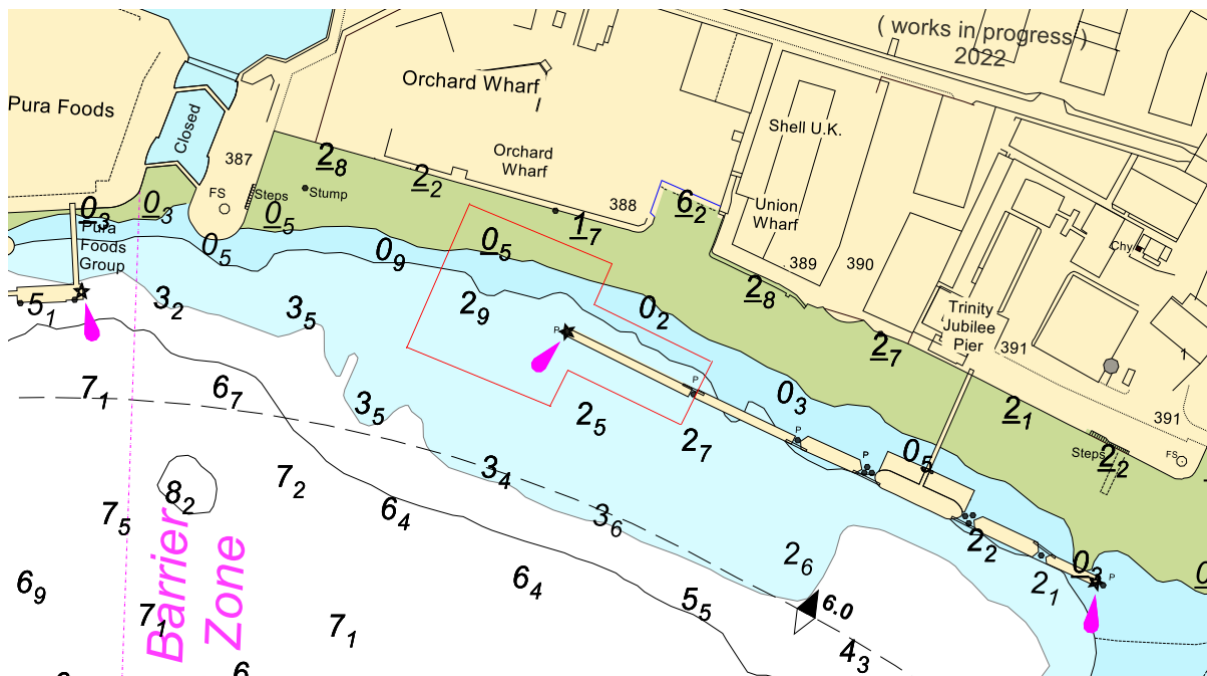


## NOTICE TO MARINERS      M30 of 2022

### BUGSBYS REACH TRINITY BUOY WHARF PIER PILING OPERATIONS

On or about the **6<sup>th</sup> June 2022**, marine contractors working on behalf of Thames Clippers will be undertaking piling operations at the upriver end of Trinity Buoy Wharf Pier.

These works will be conducted from TOPJACK JUB, which will be berthed in the works area as denoted on the chart extract below. The works will take approximately **one-week** to complete and working hours will be **07:00 to 17:00 daily**.



The works will be supported by the Tug ZEEHOND, which will maintain a continuous listening watch on VHF channel 14.

Requirements to proceed with caution or at slow speed will be made in accordance with the procedure set out in the Port of London Authority's [Port Information Guide](#), under 'London VTS', 'Section 4'.

Further details will be broadcast by **London VTS** on **VHF Channel 14** as required.
