

NOTICE TO MARINERS M34 of 2017

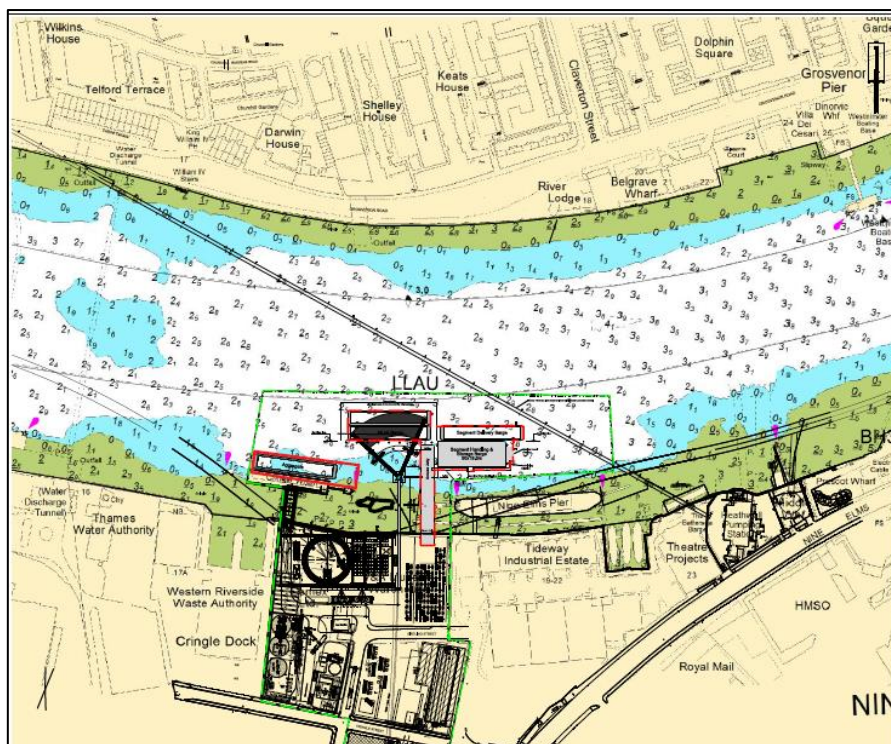
NINE ELMS REACH KIRTLING STREET WORKS SITE JETTY CONSTRUCTION

Mariners are advised that on or about 28th April 2017, contractors working on the Tideway Tunnel Project will commence construction of a new jetty at the Kirtling Street works site adjacent to Nine Elms Pier. The works are expected to last until December 2017.

The Crane Barge HAVEN SEA BREEZE and Jack Up Barge HAVEN SEARISER 2 will be on site during the construction works and these will be supported by the supply barge HAVEN SEA VOYAGER. A safety vessel HUSKY will also be in attendance during working hours.

In addition bed levelling operations will be conducted adjacent to Cringle Wharf and the new jetty construction area. These works will be conducted by the ARNAUD REGIS supported by a small hopper barge.

Please see the chartlet below depicting the location of the construction works.



Crane and Jack Up Barges will display the lights and shapes as prescribed in Rule 27 of the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea 1972 namely:

- By day, three black shapes in a vertical line the highest and lowest of which are balls and the middle one a diamond.
- By night, three all round lights in a vertical line the highest and lowest of which are red and the middle one white.

The works will involve repositioning the crane and jack up barge, piling, diving and lifting operations. Vessels involved in the works will maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 14.

Vessels are requested to be mindful of the nature of the works, their wash when passing the works and to pass at a safe distance.

London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to “proceed with caution” or “proceed at slow speed”, as described in Permanent Notices to Mariners 4 of 2014 as required by the works. International Code flags “Romeo Yankee” will be displayed only when this is in effect.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
