KING'S REACH SOUTHWARK BRIDGE ARCH CLOSURES

Contractors working on behalf of the City of London will be conducting abseiling survey operations on Southwark Bridge from **Sunday 25th October 2020 until Wednesday 28th October 2020**. In order to accommodate these works the following arches will be closed to navigation:

Works will be undertaken by abseil and Safety Boat PRONTO will be in attendance throughout the operations, maintaining a listening watch on VHF channel 14.

All vessels are asked to navigate with caution when passing the works.

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws 2012 namely:

- By day, three red discs 0.6 metres in diameter at the points of an equilateral triangle with the apex downwards and the base horizontal
- By night, three red lights in similar positions to the discs displayed by day.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
