UPPER POOL TO CHELSEA REACH **RESCHEDULED** **DOGGETT'S COAT & BADGE WAGER**

Mariners are advised that on **Thursday 28th July 2022** the rescheduled 2022 Doggett's Coat and Badge Wager will take place between London Bridge and Albert Bridge at 10:30. It is expected that one scull will take part in the race.

In order to support this event, mariners are requested to navigate with caution, paying particular attention to their wash from 10:15 through the event area.

The river will not be closed but a Harbour Service Launch, Call Sign prefix "Thames Patrol", will follow the event, displaying flashing blue lights. The Launch will conduct Local Traffic Control, if and when necessary.

The wager will be controlled by an Umpires' launch and attending safety RIBs.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on **VHF Channel 14**.
