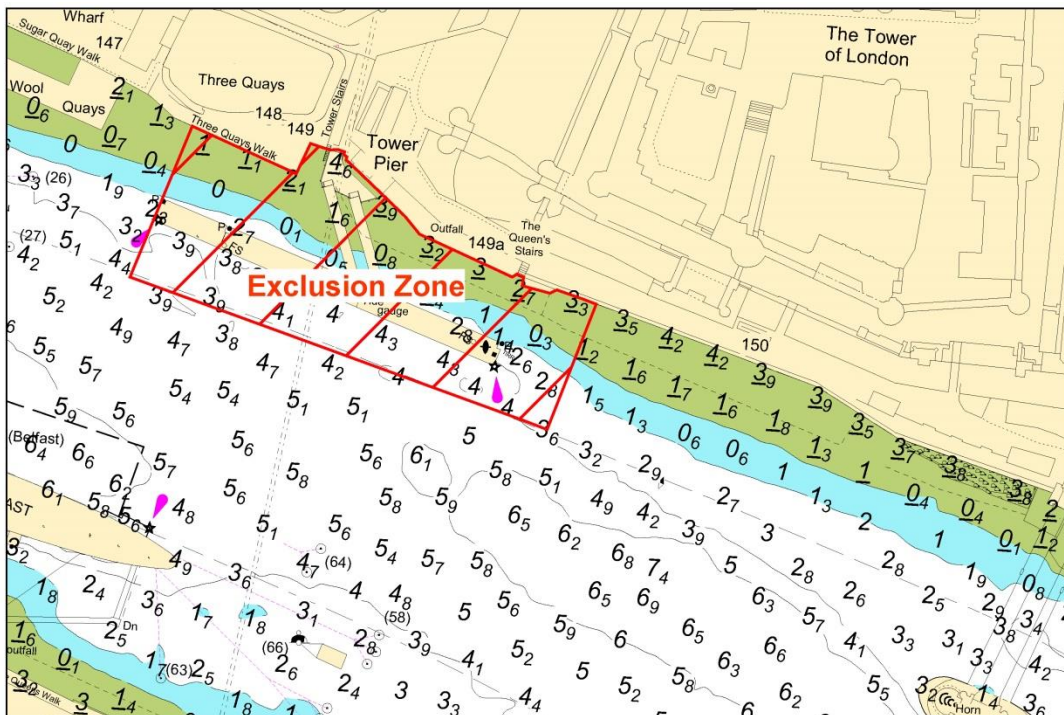


NOTICE TO MARINERS M69 of 2019

UPPER POOL THE TOWER OF LONDON GUN SALUTE

Further to Notice to Mariners M1 of 2019, at **13:00 on Monday 14th October 2019**, a Gun Salute of 41 rounds will be fired from the Tower of London for the State Opening of Parliament.

During the firing, an exclusion zone will be established in front of the gun positions, extending 55m into the river and from the upriver end of Tower Pier to 30m downriver of the pier. (See below chartlet)



As a result Tower Pier will be cleared of all personnel and boats, 15 minutes prior to the scheduled Gun Salutes. Vessels shall not approach closer than 15 metres to the pier when navigating in the Upper Pool.

A Harbour Service Launch with flashing blue lights will patrol the vicinity of the pier to control navigation as required during the salutes.

Any changes to this notice, will be promulgated by London VTS by at least 2 half-hourly broadcasts.
