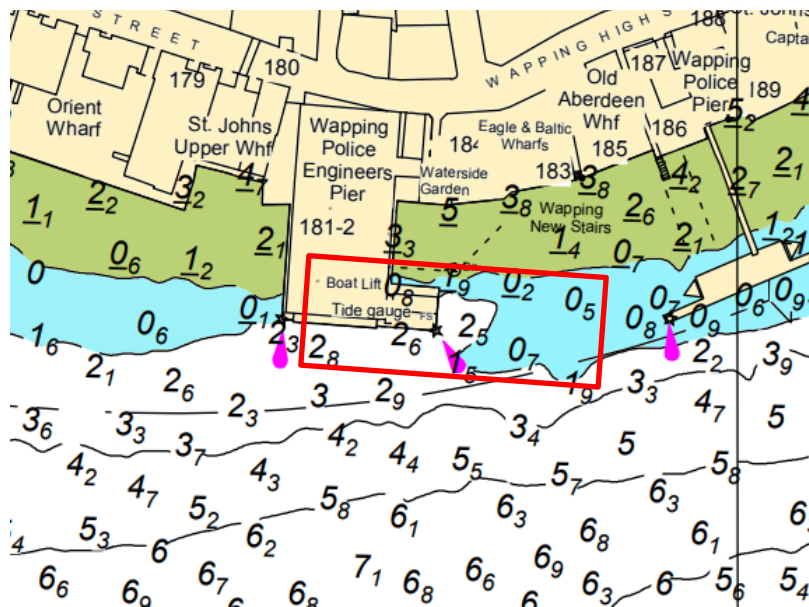


## NOTICE TO MARINERS M73 of 2019

### LOWER POOL WAPPING POLICE ENGINEERS PIER PREPARATORY WORKS

On or about **18<sup>th</sup> December 2019** Red7Marine will be working on behalf of Beckett Rankine to begin preparatory works on Wapping Police Engineers Pier. The initial works will remove various items from the boat lift in preparation for the replacement of 2 piles in February 2020, for which a supplementary Notice to Mariners will be promulgated. The chartlet below depicts the location and marine footprint of the works:



Works will be conducted using the HAVEN SEAFORTH and HAVEN SEAWAY which will moor in various locations within the footprint. Initially the spud leg barge HAVEN SEAFORTH will be mobilised to site and will be joined by the jack-up barge HAVEN SEAWAY on or around **21<sup>st</sup> December 2019**. The safety boat HUNTER will be in attendance during the works.

On or around **14<sup>th</sup> January 2020** the HAVEN SEAFORTH will moor alongside the Jack Up Barge HAVEN SEAFORTH for approximately 4 days encroaching into the main navigational channel. The barge will be lit in accordance with COLREGs Rule 30 and will, in addition, have festoon lights along the outer edge of the barge during this time. The barge will extend into the navigational channel and during this period will be included in routine VTS broadcasts.

Preparatory works will continue until late February 2020 following which further works will commence to replace the damaged piles.

London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to “proceed with caution” or “proceed at slow speed”, as described in Permanent Notices to Mariners 4 of 2014 as required by the works. International Code Flags “Romeo Yankee” will be displayed when this is in effect.

Mariners should navigate with caution in this area.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14 as required.
