

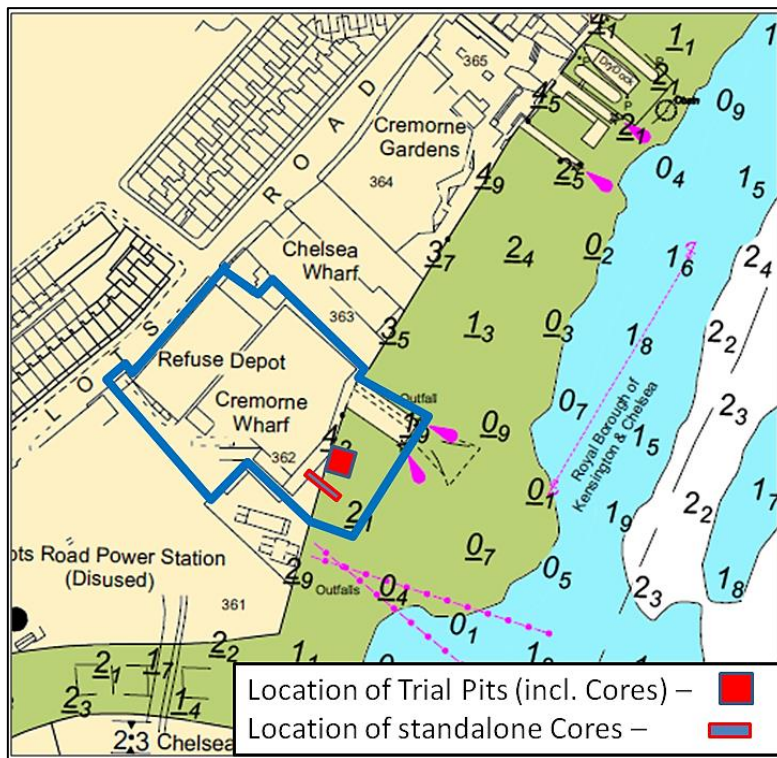
NOTICE TO MARINERS M75 of 2017

CHELSEA REACH

CREMORNE WHARF TRIAL PITS

Mariners are advised that on or about the 5th September 2017 contractors working on the Tideway Tunnel Project will dig a trial pit and take river wall core samples on the foreshore at Cremorne Wharf. These works are expected to be concluded by the 8th of September.

Please see the chartlet below depicting the location of the works.



The works will involve a shore side crane landing and lifting off a digger to and from the foreshore when accessible. Personnel will access the foreshore using a temporarily rigged ladder.

The works will take place at suitable tide heights between the working hours of 0800 to 1800.

In order to maximise the available use of the tides and complete the works in the shortest possible time the works will also be carried out in close proximity to the water's edge. Vessels are requested to be mindful of the nature of the works, the proximity of the tide to the works, their wash when passing the works and slow down accordingly.

London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to “proceed with caution” or “proceed at slow speed”, as described in Permanent Notices to Mariners 4 of 2014 as required by the works. International Code flags “Romeo Yankee” will be displayed only when this is in effect.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
