

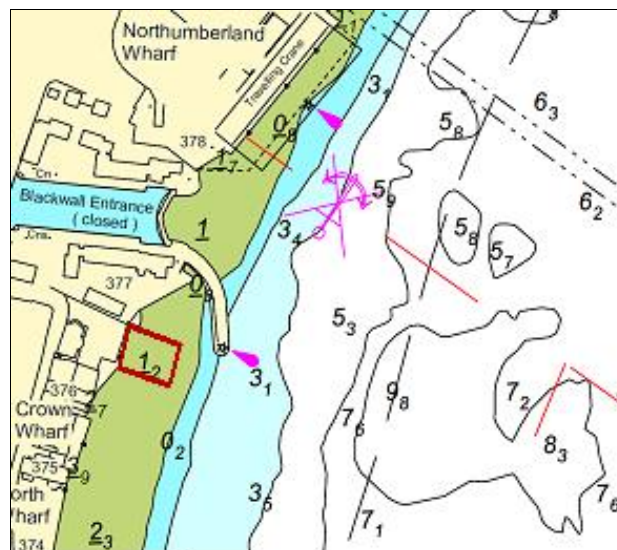
## NOTICE TO MARINERS      M83 of 2017

### BLACKWALL REACH

## COLDHARBOUR WHARF RIVER WALL MAINTENANCE

Mariners are advised that on or about 11<sup>th</sup> September 2017 contractors working on behalf of the Environment Agency will be conducting maintenance works at Coldharbour Wharf for approximately three months. The works will be supported by the multicat “DEVOUR” positioned close to the river wall.

Please see the chartlet below depicting the location of the works.



Vessels navigating in the vicinity of Coldharbour Wharf are to do so with particular caution with due regard of the works taking place. London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to “proceed with caution” or “proceed at slow speed”, as described in the Permanent Notices to Mariners 4 of 2014, as required by the works. International Code flags “Romeo Yankee” will be displayed when this is in effect.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
