

NOTICE TO MARINERS M85 of 2017

CHELSEA REACH

CHELSEA CREEK FOOTBRIDGE BRIDGE HEIGHT REDUCTION

Contractors working on behalf of Chelsea Harbour will be conducting maintenance works to Chelsea Creek Footbridge. The works will commence on or about Monday **25th September 2017**, with duration of approximately 5 months. In order to facilitate these works scaffolding will be constructed underneath the footbridge, this will reduce head room by 2.5m. The reduced headroom in the main navigational arch will reduce the bridge height meaning that the footbridge is not navigable at high water.

Reduced headroom in the arch will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws 2012 namely:

- By Day – A bundle of straw large enough to be easily visible and displayed at the height of restricted headroom;
- By Night – A white light in place of the bundle of straw

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
