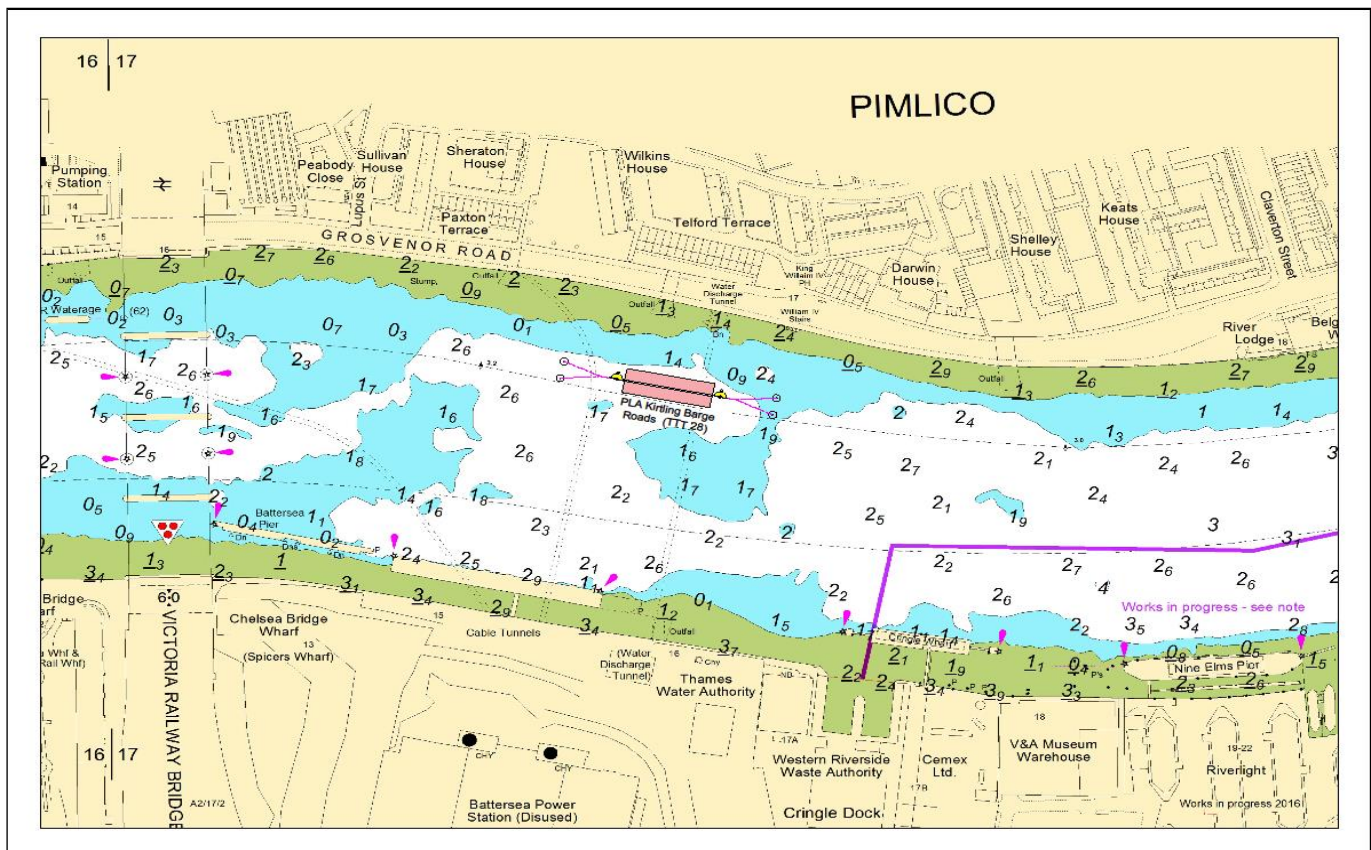


NOTICE TO MARINERS M89 of 2017

NINE ELMS REACH KIRTLING BARGE ROADS TEMPORARY BARGE MOORING

Mariners are advised that on or about 3rd October 2017 contractors working on behalf of the Thames Tideway Tunnel Project will lay a temporary barge mooring opposite Battersea Power Station. The barge mooring will be laid as a tier and will be marked by unlit Admiralty class buoys, identified as 'Kirtling Barge Roads'. It is anticipated this tier will be in place for approximately four years.

The PLA vessel LONDON TITAN will lay the temporary barge mooring as indicated on the below chartlet.



London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to “proceed with caution” or “proceed at slow speed”, as described in Permanent Notices to Mariners 4 of 2014 as required by the works. International Code flags “Romeo Yankee” will be displayed when this is in effect.

Operators of vessels are to pay particular attention to the LONDON TITAN and to navigate with caution whilst passing the works.

Further details of the works by LONDON TITAN and of any obstructions will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
