

NOTICE TO AGENTS, BERTH AND SHIP OPERATORS No. 4 of 2017

ON DUTY TIME FOR TUGS PRIOR TO ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

Agents, berth and ship operators are required to ensure they book any required tugs to be on station ready to make fast a minimum of 15 minutes before the ship's booked departure time. This ensures there is plenty of time for the plan to be agreed with tug and pilot as well as give time to make fast prior to the vessel letting go at the scheduled departure time.

This follows a number of situations where a vessel has been delayed due to the tug not arriving until the actual departure time following instruction from the vessel's agents, berth or operator.

Any changes to the vessel's departure time should be relayed to the tug operating company accordingly.
