

NOTICE TO MARINERS U1 of 2019

HORSE REACH (LOWER) RICHMOND RAIL BRIDGE ARCH CLOSURES

Contractors working on behalf of Network Rail will be conducting survey operations at Richmond Rail Bridge from **Monday 21st January 2019** until **Thursday 24th January 2019**. In order to accommodate these works, arches on Richmond Rail Bridge will be closed to navigation as follows:

Local Traffic Control will be undertaken from a PLA Harbour Service Launch in the vicinity of Richmond Rail Bridge for the duration of the closures in arch 2. All vessels intending to navigate between Richmond Lock and Petersham Ait are to call 'RICHMOND CONTROL' on VHF Channel 14 as follows:

- Inbound before departing Richmond Lock
- Outbound at Petersham Ait
- Prior to leaving a berth or mooring between Richmond Lock and Petersham Ait.

Survey operations will take place from modular pontoons and workboat WALLY will be in attendance throughout, maintaining a listening watch on VHF channel 14.

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws 2012 namely:

- By day, three red discs 0.6 metres in diameter at the points of an equilateral triangle with the apex downwards and the base horizontal
- By night, three red lights in similar positions to the discs displayed by day.

Further details will be broadcast by **London VTS** on VHF Channel 14.
