

## NOTICE TO MARINERS U4 of 2020

### KEW RAIL BRIDGE NO. 5 ARCH CLOSURE

Contractors working on behalf of Network Rail will be conducting survey works by rope access on Kew Rail Bridge on or about **Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020**. In order to accommodate these works, No. 5 of Kew Rail Bridge will be closed to navigating from 08:00 to 16:00

Safety boat WHALEY will be on station maintaining a listening watch on VHF Channel 14.

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws 2012 namely:

- By day, three red discs 0.6 metres in diameter at the points of an equilateral triangle with the apex downwards and the base horizontal
- By night, three red lights in similar positions to the discs displayed by day.

Further details will be broadcast by **London VTS** on VHF Channel 14.
