

NOTICE TO MARINERS No.10 of 2011

BOW CREEK

REGULATION OF NAVIGATION

Supplementary Information to NTM 8 of 2009

This notice should be read in conjunction with Port Wide Notice to Mariners 8 of 2009 and is to be considered as supplementary information to that notice.

Background

On or about the 21st of July 2011, work will begin on a temporary footbridge crossing the River Lea immediately in the approach to Three Mills Lock. Similarly works will also commence in this area just upriver of the temporary footbridge to allow for barges to be accommodated alongside the river bank to take excavated material from the Lea Tunnel Project. When the works are complete the "Muck Away" is anticipated to continue until the 30th of June 2012. While these works and muck away are ongoing, navigational access to Three Mills Lock may be restricted at certain times.

Requirement

From the 14th of July 2011 until the 30th of June 2012, in addition to the information and requirements contained in Notice to Mariners 8 of 2009, vessels requiring to navigate above the Twelve Trees Road Bridge are to contact the Lock Keeper at Three Mills Lock on Tel No 0207 517 5570, VHF 14 Monday to Friday 0800 to 1600 in order to receive instructions where it is necessary to use the alternative Bow Locks when the use of Three Mills Lock is not possible.
