The PLA (Port of London Authority) has recently created a new recreational users website which has been developed to provide leisure users with all the information they need to stay safe on the river.

The new website provides guidance on the following types of river leisure:

- Rowing
- Sailing
- Water Sports

Each of the links above contain guidance documents, links to river associations and point of contacts within the PLA.

A key innovation is the inclusion of two videos on 'How To' navigate on the Thames – one for powered craft like narrow boats, the other for un-powered craft like rowing boats. These almost 'hold the hand' of the navigator through the busiest and most tricky sections of the river through central London.
