

## **NOTICE TO MARINERS**      No.M53 of 2011

### **BATTERSEA REACH**

### **BATTERSEA SHOAL - REDUCED DEPTHS**

Recent hydrographic surveys indicate that the main finger waves on Battersea Shoal have extended and shoaled significantly into the authorised channel, resulting in a Least Depth inside the channel of 0.2m (previously 0.9m).

The 1m contour on the main shoal now extends some 18m into the channel from the southern edge of the authorised channel.

This position is approximately mid-way between Battersea Bridge and the top of the PLA Driftwood mooring and right opposite the small break of open water between the upper and lower sets of moorings at Cheyne Walk (see chartlet overleaf).

Mariners are reminded that it is a requirement to carry appropriate up to date nautical publications, where available.
