

NOTICE TO MARINERS No.M63 of 2011

WOOLWICH REACH

HOOKNESS SHOAL - REDUCED DEPTHS

Recent hydrographic surveys indicate Hookness Shoal to have reduced depths of up to 0.5m less than charted.

Least depths of 3.5m (previously 4.0m) now exist 30m inside of the North Channel Edge. The 4m contour now extends some 40m into the channel at this point.

The shoal on the South Channel Edge has a least depth of 5.4m and extends 76m inside the South Channel Edge.
