GREENWICH REACH CONTROLLED NAVIGATION FIREWORK DISPLAY SUNDAY 5TH FEBRUARY 2012

On **Sunday 5th February** there will be a firework display from barges positioned mid-stream in Greenwich Reach off the Old Royal Naval College. The display will commence at 1800 and will last for approximately 15 minutes.

Controlled Navigation will be in force prior to and during this Firework Display. The Harbour Service Launch will be in attendance to Control Navigation as required.

All vessels navigating on the river above or below the Greenwich Pier area at this time are requested to pay particular attention to this event and maintain a continuous watch on VHF Channel 14, following instructions from the attendant Harbour Service Launches, call sign **Thames Patrol**, also on VHF Channel 14.

Owners and operators are reminded that no manned vessels other than emergency service vessels responding to an incident and vessels engaged in fireworks operations are permitted within the closure area.

Further details will be promulgated by **London VTS** on VHF Channel 14 during routine river broadcasts.
