

NOTICE TO MARINERS No.M84 of 2011

UPPER POOL TOWER BRIDGE No1 & 3 ARCH CLOSURES

Contractors working on behalf of the City of London are installing new LED lighting at Tower Bridge, in order to accommodate these works No1 and No3 arches at Tower Bridge will be closed to navigation as follows,

- **On the 4th January 2012 08.00 until 17th January 2012 18.00, No 1 arch will be closed to navigation.**
- **On the 18th January 2012 08.00 until 31st January 2012 18.00, No 3 arch will be closed to navigation.**

A safety boat will be on station throughout operations.

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority River Byelaws 1978 (as amended) namely:

- By day, three red discs 0.6 metres in diameter at the points of an equilateral triangle with the apex downwards and the base horizontal
- By night, three red lights in similar positions to the discs displayed by day.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
