

NOTICE TO MARINERS No.U4 of 2012

BARN ELMS REACH INSTALLATION OF TEMPORARY MOORINGS FOR THE QUEEN'S DIAMOND JUBILEE

Marine Services working on behalf of the Thames Diamond Jubilee Pageant will, on or about the 10th April 2012, lay two lines of mooring trots in Barn Elms Reach, from just upstream of Barn Elms boat house to the Harrods Depository. These trots will be laid on either side of the authorised channel on or about the 1m pecked line (see the attached chartlet for the locations of the trots). The buoys will be removed in the week following the Queen's Diamond Jubilee which takes place on the 3rd June, with the trots being removed during the following month.

During the installation a number of Driftwood craft, barges and accompanying tenders will be in the area and river users should keep well clear of these vessels while works are taking place. The mooring buoys in these trots will be unlit; however there will be a special mark buoy (Fl. Y) positioned at the start and finish of the trots on each shore.

Directions to fine boat rowers

During the installation of the moorings and for the entire period that they are in place fine boat rowers are not to row through the area. This has been agreed with representatives of local boat clubs as a matter of navigational safety.

Directions to all other river users

During the installation of the moorings, and for the entire period that they are in place, river users should pass through the area with caution, and should navigate line astern if safely possible.

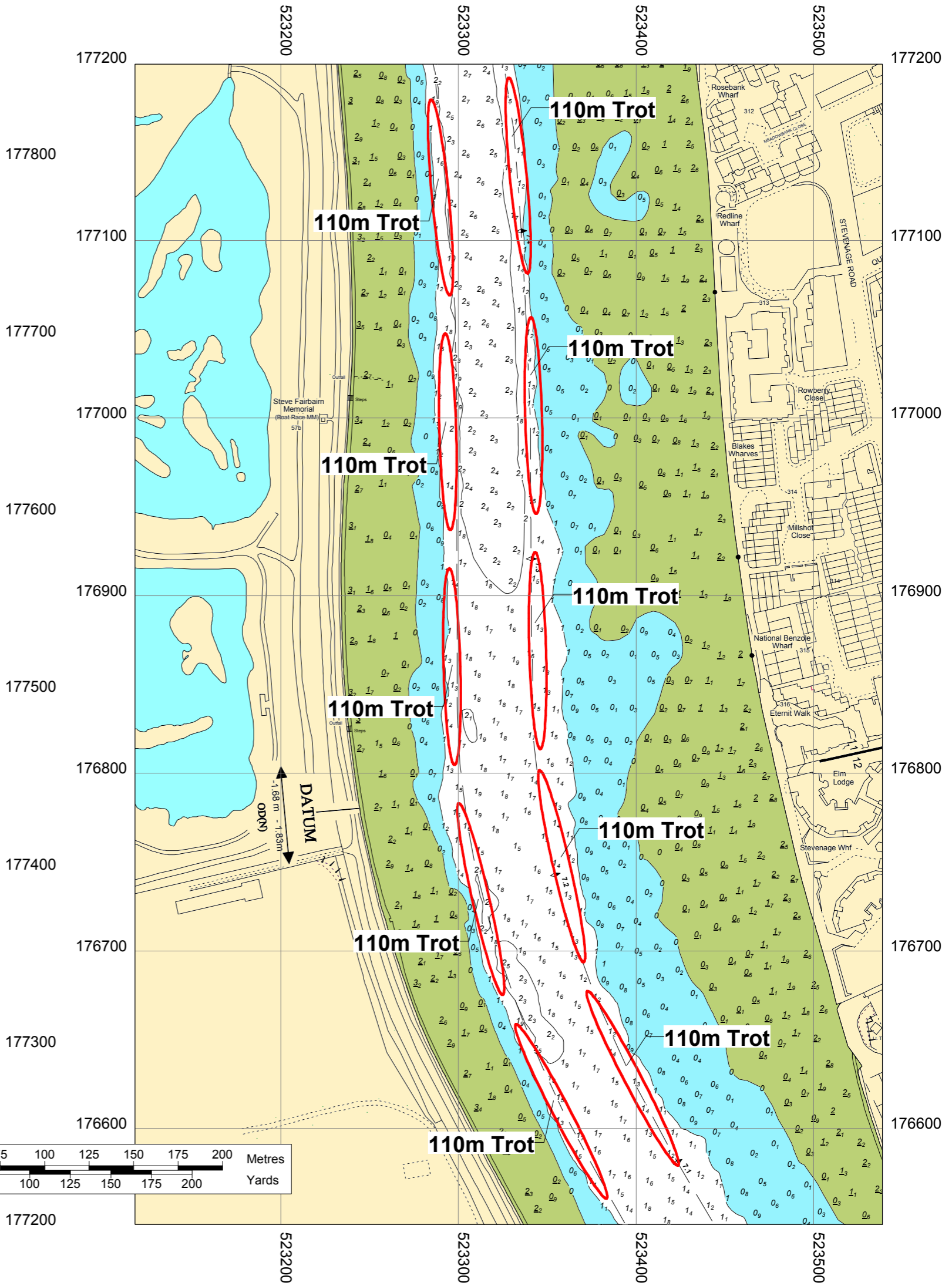
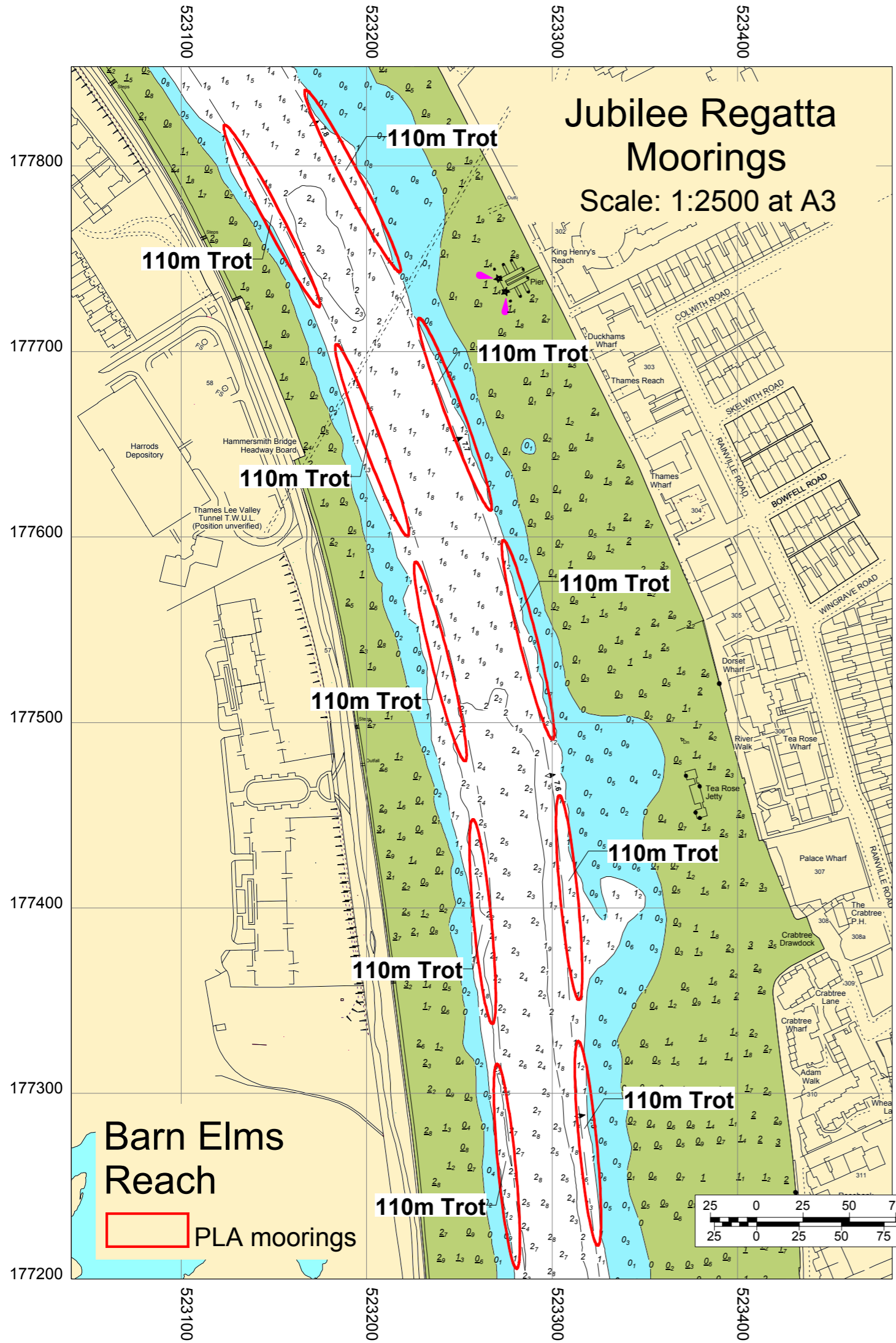
