

NOTICE TO AGENTS, BERTH AND SHIP OPERATORS No.2 of 2012

PETROPLUS CORYTON REFINERY RELOCATION OF BERTHING SERVICE

The shipping situation at Coryton Refinery remains unclear and patchy for the moment and hence the Berthing Pilot service has been withdrawn from the Coryton dock office. Berthing Pilots and navigational information concerning berthing and un-berthing at Coryton, Shell Sierra, Calor Gas and Oikos jetties will now operate from Gravesend until further notice.

Therefore, the Duty Port Controller should be contacted with regards to all pre-berthing queries and Sea Reach timings. Once the berthing / sailing time has been confirmed, a berthing pilot will be allocated from the sea roster.
