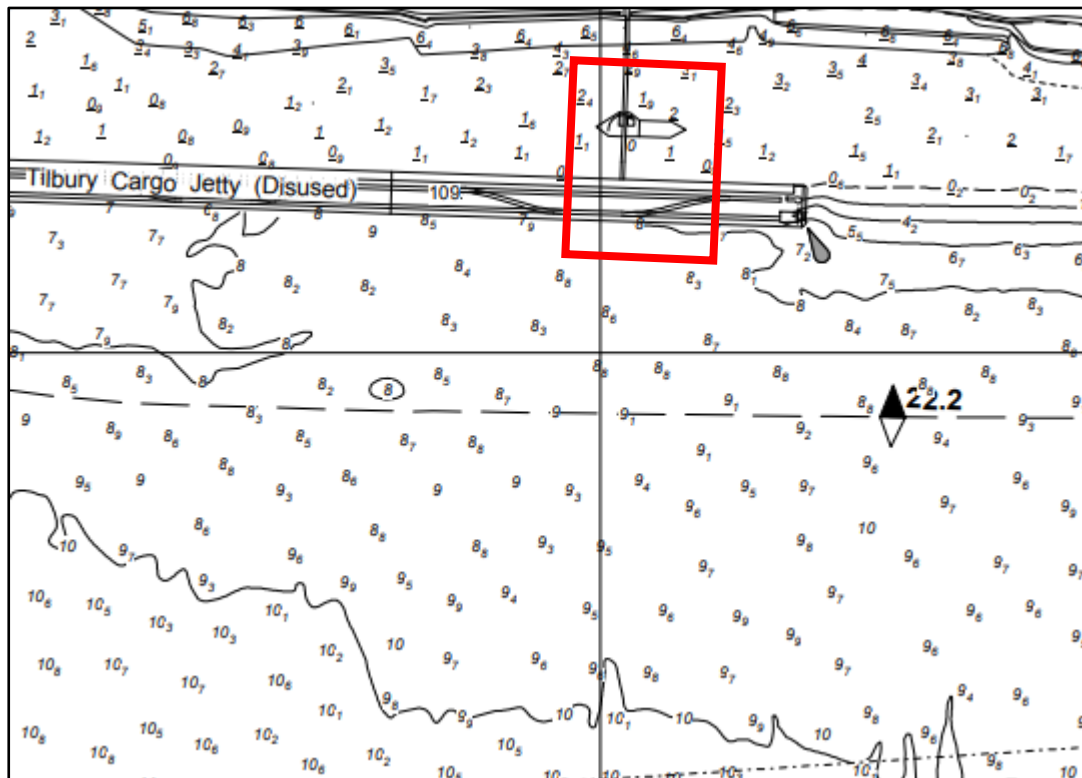


NOTICE TO MARINERS L16 of 2021

GRAVESEND REACH TILBURY CARGO JETTY FOOTBRIDGE REMOVAL

On or about **Monday 23rd August 2021** contractors working on behalf of the Port of Tilbury will commence removal of a disused footbridge and supporting structure from Tilbury Cargo Jetty. The works will be undertaken between approximately 0600 and 1630, Monday to Friday, and are expected to take up to one month to complete.

The chartlet below indicates the approximate footprint of the marine operations:



The works will include cutting, heavy lifting operations and operatives working on the water line using a variety of crane barges, pontoons, tugs and support vessels.

London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to "Proceed at Slow Speed" or "Proceed with Caution" as required by the works. International Code Flags "Romeo Yankee" will be displayed in accordance with General Direction 18. Port wide Notice to Mariners 8 of 2021 refers.

Further details will be broadcast by **London VTS** on VHF Channel 68.
