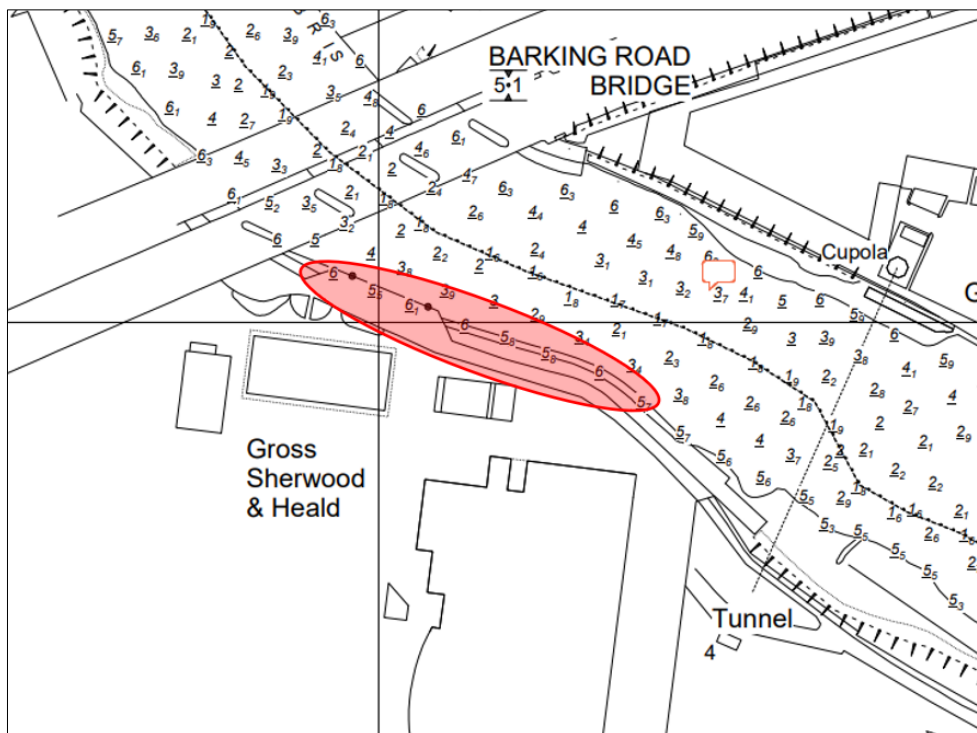


BARKING REACH

BARKING CREEK RIVER RODING

Mariners are advised that, from **Thursday 1st February** onwards, contractors will be completing repair work on the sheet pile wall and capping beam at the River Roding, south of Barking Road Bridge. Works will last for four months, and operations will take place between the hours of 0700 and 1800. Exact location can be seen on the chartlet below:



Requirements to proceed with caution or at slow speed will be made in accordance with the procedures set out in the Port of London Authority's Port Information Guide, under 'London VTS', 'Section 4' with the International Code Flags 'Romeo Yankee (RY)', which are illustrated below, displayed.

Further details will be broadcast as needed by **London VTS** on **VHF channels 14**.
