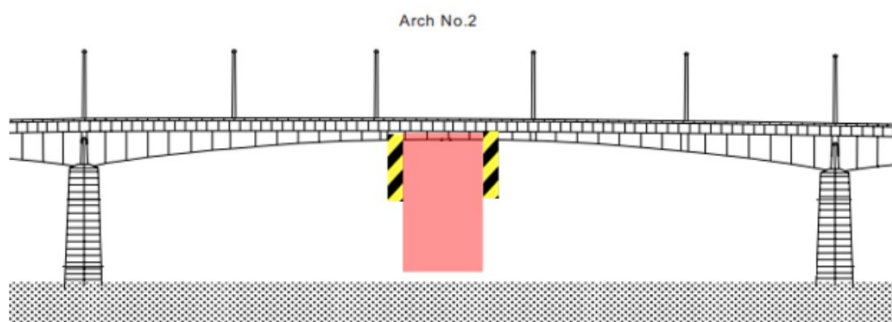
LONDON BRIDGE

NAVIGATION LIGHT WORKS

& LOCAL TRAFFIC CONTROL

On or about Monday 27th November 2023 contractors will be conducting essential maintenance on the Navigation Lights in the central area of Arch 2 of London Bridge. These works will take place overnight between 2300 and 0500 and are expected to last 3 nights. During these works the signal lights will be extinguished.

To accommodate these works, an arch restriction will be in place. This will be marked by lit chevron boards on the outer extremities of the work. Vessels should not navigate in the area between the boards as illustrated below:

Furthermore, the PLA Harbour Service Launch will be conducting Local Traffic Control in King's Reach and the Upper Pool.

Local Traffic Control will be undertaken from a PLA Harbour Service Launch stationed in the vicinity of London Bridge. All vessels intending to navigate between Hermitage Community Moorings and Blackfriars Road Bridge are to call 'LONDON BRIDGE CONTROL' on VHF Channel 14 as follows:

- Inbound at Hermitage Community Moorings
- Outbound at Blackfriars Road Bridge
- Prior to leaving a berth or mooring between Hermitage Community Moorings and Blackfriars Road Bridge

Further information will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
