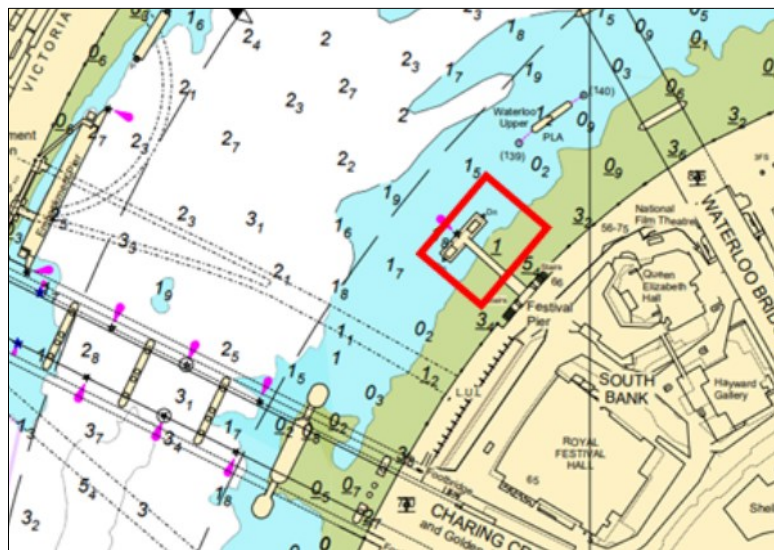


## KINGS REACH

# FESTIVAL PIER

On or about 8<sup>th</sup> January 2024, contractors from County Building Services Ltd will commence brow bearing replacement works at Festival Pier. These works are expected to take approximately 1 month. Festival pier will be closed throughout the works.

A multicat workboat and small open workboat will be used to facilitate this work, including the installation of a lifting beam.



Requirements for vessels to proceed with caution or pass at slow speed will be made by London VTS on VHF ch.14, in accordance with the Port of London Authority's [Port Information Guide](#), under 'London VTS', section 4. When this is applicable, 'RY' signals will be displayed.



Masters of passing vessels should have due regard for the effects of their wash including the possibility of rebound from the river wall and the combined effect of wash from other vessels.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on **VHF Channel 14**, as required.
