

NOTICE TO MARINERS M11 of 2020

LOWER POOL WAPPING POLICE PIER URGENT REPAIR WORKS

On or about **2**nd **April 2020** Red7Marine will undertake urgent repair works on Wapping Police Pier, which are anticipated to take approximately four weeks. The chartlet below depicts the location and marine footprint of the works:



The works will be undertaken from the jack-up barge HAVEN SEASEVEN and the spud leg barge HAVEN SEAFORTH and will take up position inside the upper end of the pier.

Following the repairs to the upper restraint piles the HAVEN SEASEVEN will be mobilised to a position inside the lower end of the pier. The HAVEN SEAFORTH will be mobilised to the lower outer side of the pier where it will encroach into the navigational channel. The safety boat HUNTER will be in attendance during the works.

London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to "proceed with caution" or "proceed at slow speed", as described in Permanent Notices to Mariners 4 of 2014 as required by the works. International Code Flags "Romeo Yankee" will be displayed when this is in effect.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14 as required.
