

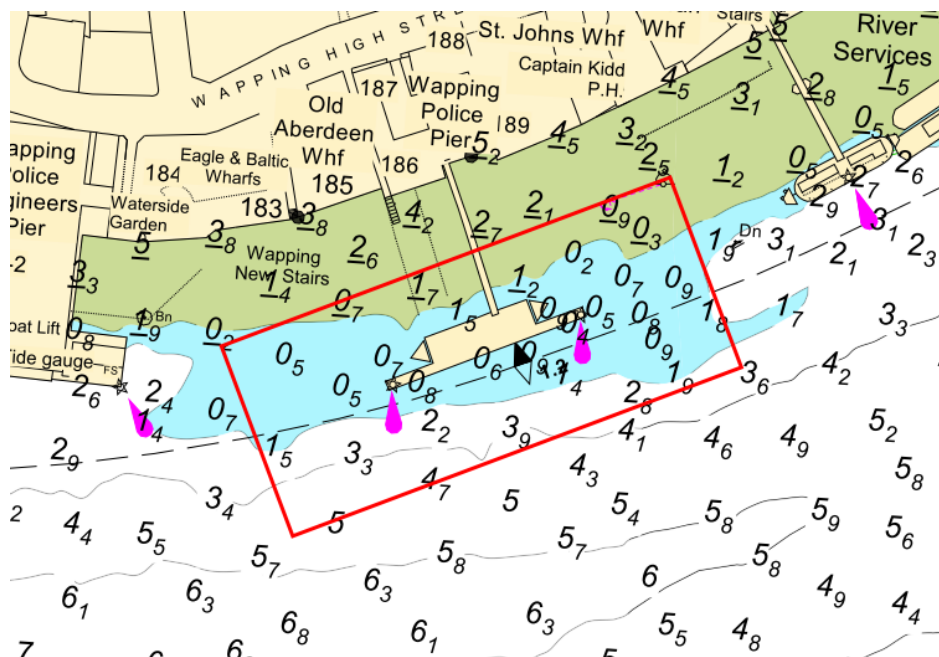
NOTICE TO MARINERS M12 of 2021

LOWER POOL DREDGING OPERATIONS

On or about 17th March 2021, contractors working on behalf the Metropolitan Police Service will be undertaking dredging operations at Wapping Police Pier, which will take approximately 7-weeks.

In order to accommodate these works, the spud leg barge DEVELOPER will conduct the dredge operations with the excavated materials being placed into an awaiting barge moored alongside the DEVELOPER. Tug PROSPER will be in attendance to manoeuvre the barges around the dredge site. Dredge operations will take place Monday to Friday during the hours of 07:00 to 18:00.

The chartlet below indicates the approximate footprint of the marine works.



The dredge vessel should display lights and signals as per the International Regulations for Prevention of Collision at Sea (27).

London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to “Proceed at Slow Speed” or” Proceed with Caution” as required by the works. International Code Flags “Romeo Yankee” will be displayed when this is in effect as per the requirements of Notice to Mariners No. 1 of 2021.

Further details will be broadcast by **London VTS** on VHF Channel 14.
