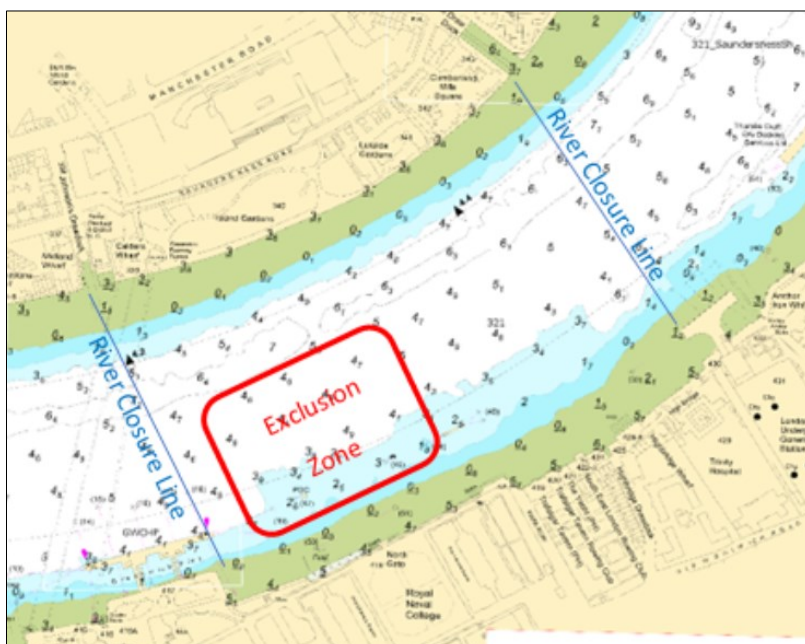


GREENWICH REACH

TEMPORARY RIVER CLOSURE

Mariners are advised, on SATURDAY 10th FEBRUARY 2024, a private fireworks display for the Chinese New Year, will be held opposite the Royal Naval College, Greenwich Reach. The fireworks are due to begin at or around 22:15 and will last for approximately 7 minutes.



An EXCLUSION AREA will be established at 22:10, to the extent seen below. The fireworks will be fired from vessel Scheldemond, which will manoeuvre into a position approximately 100 to 150 meters from the south bank, in front of the Royal Naval College, for the duration of the display. The exclusion zone will be removed at 22:25, after the completion of the fireworks.

For the duration of the fireworks display, a RIVER CLOSURE, to the extent seen below, will be enforced starting from 22:10, between, a line drawn from the downstream end of Greenwich Pier on the South Bank and Johnson's Draw Dock on the north bank, to, a line drawn from the upstream end of Greenwich Power Station Pier on the south bank and Newcastle Draw Dock on the north bank. The river is to be opened at 22:25, after completion of the fireworks.

Enforcement of the exclusion area and river closure will be undertaken by a PLA Harbour Service Launch which will be positioned between the river closure and in vicinity of the exclusion area. Contact can be made with traffic control on VHF Channel 14, calling 'GREENWICH CONTROL'.

Further information will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
