

NOTICE TO MARINERS M27 of 2022

NINE ELMS REACH GROSVENOR RAIL BRIDGE ARCH CLOSURES & LOCAL TRAFFIC CONTROL

On 29th May 2022 contractors working on behalf of Network Rail will be undertaking remedial works to netting on Grosvenor Rail Bridge. In order to accommodate the works, Arch 3 will be Closed to Navigation as follows:

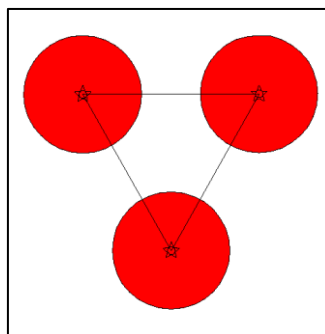
Date	Time	Arch	Navigational Information
Sunday 29 th May	10:00 – 14:00	3	Closed to Navigation & Local Traffic Control

Local Traffic Control will be undertaken from a PLA Harbour Service Launch in the vicinity of Grosvenor Rail Bridge for the duration of the closure of arch 3. All vessels intending to navigate between Vauxhall Bridge and Albert Bridge are to call '**VICTORIA CONTROL**' on VHF Channel 14 as follows:

- Inbound at Vauxhall Bridge
- Outbound at Albert Bridge
- Prior to leaving a berth or mooring between Vauxhall Bridge and Albert Bridge

Safety Boat **PROTECTOR** will be in attendance throughout these operations and will be maintaining a listening watch on VHF Channel 14.

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws 2012:



Further details will be broadcast by **London VTS** on **VHF Channel 14**.
