

**NOTICE TO MARINERS M33 of 2022**  
**LIMEHOUSE REACH**  
**TEMPORARY BOOM LIMEKILN DOCK**

On or about Thursday 9th June 2022, the Port of London Authority will be conducting works on the river walls at the entrance of Limekiln Dock in Limehouse Reach.

Works will be undertaken by a PLA DRIFTWOOD vessel over the high-water period. During these works a proceed with caution or at slow speed will be made in accordance with the procedure set out in the Port of London Authority's Port Information Guide, under 'London VTS', 'Section 4'.

Towards the end of June 2022, a temporary debris boom will be installed across the entrance of Limekiln Dock and will remain in place until further notice.

The PLA DRIFTWOOD when on station will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 14.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14, as required.
