UPPER POOL TOWER BRIDGE 1 & 3 ARCH CLOSURES

On or about the 28 August 2020 contractors working on the Tideway Tunnel Project will install Invar Staffs on the North Pier in No 1 arch and on the South Pier in No 3 arch using abseilors within the arches.

No 3 arch will be closed from approximately 0515 to 0700 and no 1 arch 0715 to 0900.

In the event that the works in no 3 arch significantly over run, then the works in no 1 arch will take place from approximately 0515 to 0700 on the 29th August.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws 2012 namely:

- By day, three red discs 0.6 metres in diameter at the points of an equilateral triangle with the apex downwards and the base horizontal
- By night, three red lights in similar positions to the discs displayed by day
