KINGS REACH MILLENNIUM BRIDGE MAINTENANCE LOCAL TRAFFIC CONTROL

On Saturday 5th September contractors working on behalf of the City of London will be conducting maintenance in arch 2 of Millennium Bridge. The works will be conducted by abseil and indicated on the bridge by tiger stripes on the outer extremities of the works. In order to accommodate these works the PLA Harbour Service Launch will be conducting local traffic control in King's Reach as follows:

Local Traffic Control will be undertaken from a PLA Harbour Service Launch stationed in the vicinity of Millennium Bridge. All vessels intending to navigate between Southwark Bridge and Blackfriars Road Bridge are to call 'MILLENNIUM BRIDGE CONTROL' on VHF Channel 14 as follows:



- Inbound at Southwark Bridge
- Outbound at Blackfriars Road Bridge
- Prior to leaving a berth or mooring between Southwark Bridge and Blackfriars Road Bridge
