

NOTICE TO MARINERS M37 of 2021

LIMEHOUSE REACH CANARY WHARF PIER MAINTENANCE WORKS

On or about Monday 20th September 2021, Taziker Industrial and DiveCo working on behalf of Canary Wharf Management will be undertaking maintenance works on Canary Wharf Pier which are expected to take about 5-weeks.

To support these works pontoons will be moored in various locations around the pier, however, services using the pier will not be obstructed. Contractors will be working Monday to Friday between the hours of 08:00 to 18:00. However, the pontoons will be moored alongside 24/7.

Requirements to proceed with caution or at slow speed will be made in accordance with Notice to Mariners No. 8 of 2021.

The HUNTER will be on station during working hours and maintain a watch on VHF Channel 14.

Vessels need to be aware that pontoons and workers may be behind the pier and obscured from sight and pay due to regard to the impact of their wash both directly and that reflected off the river walls in conjunction with wash from other vessels.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14 as required.
