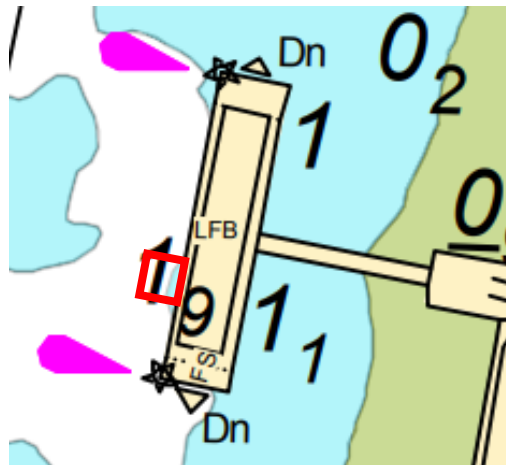


## NOTICE TO MARINERS      M50 of 2022

### LAMBETH REACH LAMBETH FIRE PIER WORKS & OBSTRUCTION

On or about 10<sup>th</sup> August 2022 contractors working on behalf of London Fire Brigade will install a temporary scaffold on the upper outer face of Lambeth Fire Pier in order to effect repairs to the fendering. Construction of the scaffolding is expected to take approximately 3 days and the daily working hours will be from 0700 to 1700. The chartlet below indicates the approximate footprint of the marine works:



During the construction phase, requests for vessels to proceed with caution or pass at slow speed may be made by London VTS on VHF Ch. 14, in accordance with the Port of London Authority's [Port Information Guide](#), under 'London VTS', section 4. In which case 'RY' signals will be displayed:

The scaffolding is anticipated to remain in position for approximately two months. During this time, the upper outer face of the pier will be obstructed by the scaffolding.
