Contractors working on behalf of Network Rail will be conducting survey operations on Cannon Street Rail Bridge from **Monday 11th January 2021 until Saturday 30th January 2021**. In order to accommodate these works the following arches will be closed to navigation:

Works will be undertaken by abseil in Arches 1 and 5, with Safety Boat WATCHDOG in attendance.

Works will be undertaken from MEWPs on the deck of the barge ROVER, manoeuvred by tug THAMES VIXEN in Arches 2, 3 and 4. Safety Boat ARTEMIS will be in attendance throughout these operations.

Attending vessels will be maintaining a listening watch on VHF channel 14.

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws 2012 namely:

- By day, three red discs 0.6 metres in diameter at the points of an equilateral triangle with the apex downwards and the base horizontal
- By night, three red lights in similar positions to the discs displayed by day.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
