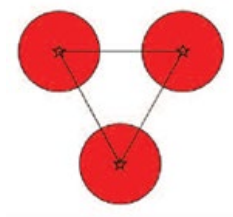
RICHMOND LOCK AND WEIR

NO. 4 ARCH CLOSURE AND WEIR POSITION

Mariners are advised that due to planned maintenance of the weir in No. 4 arch (the Surrey Arch) of Richmond Lock & Weir, the weir will remain in the lowered position and **closed to navigation**, at all times until a repair has been rectified.

During this time, only No 2 and 3 arches will be open to navigation around the high-water periods, with the Lock fully functional throughout. Mariners of vessels and recreational river users intending to navigate through these arches are advised to consider the increase in the flow rates and the possibility of eddies when transiting.

Vessels should maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 14 for any instructions from a Harbour Service Launch or London VTS and are to navigate with particular care and proceed at slow speed with due regard to their wash.



Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws 2012 as depicted and by night lit with three red lights in a downward triangle.

Further details will be broadcast by **London VTS** on VHF Channel 14.
