

NOTICE TO MARINERS U14 of 2018

SHEENGULLS REACH

ISLEWORTH AIT

DECONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION WORKS

Contractors working on behalf of the London Wildlife Trust will be conducting deconstruction and installation works at Isleworth Ait Landing Pontoon, which is located channel side on the upper end of the Ait, from **Monday 16th July 2018** for approximately two-weeks. This will involve extracting the existing piles for the landing pontoon and installing new piles, pontoon and associated works.

In order to accommodate these works crane barge BERTHA and tug TEDDINGTON will be on station throughout, which will be maintaining a listening watch on VHF Channel 14. Mooring lines and anchors will be deployed in the vicinity of the crane barge to support these operations.

Vessels navigating in the vicinity of these works are to do so with particular caution with due regard of the works taking place.

London VTS will broadcast requests for vessels to “proceed with caution” or “proceed at slow speed”, as described in the Permanent Notices to Mariners 4 of 2014, as required by the works. International Code flags “Romeo Yankee” will be displayed when this is in effect.

Further details will be broadcast by **London VTS** on **VHF Channel 14**.
