HORSE REACH TWICKENHAM BRIDGE ARCH CLOSURES & LOCAL TRAFFIC CONTROL

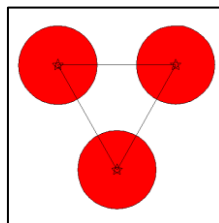
Contractors working on behalf of Transport for London will be conducting inspections on Twickenham Bridge from **Tuesday 5th July to Friday 8th July 2022**. In order to accommodate these works, arches on Twickenham Bridge will be closed to navigation for **ALL** vessels as follows:

Local Traffic Control will be undertaken from a PLA Harbour Service Launch in the vicinity of Twickenham Bridge for the duration of the closures in arch 2. All vessels intending to navigate between Richmond Lock & Weir and Richmond Bridge are to call '**TWICKENHAM CONTROL**' on VHF Channel 14 as follows:

- Inbound at Richmond Lock & Weir
- Outbound at Richmond Bridge
- Prior to leaving a berth or mooring between Richmond Lock & Weir and Richmond Bridge

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws 2012:
